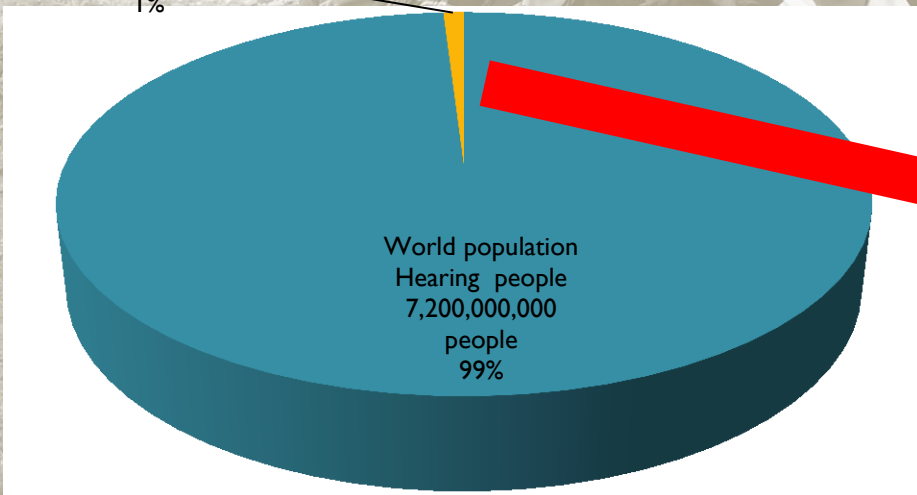


Report from WFD

(=2,100,000)

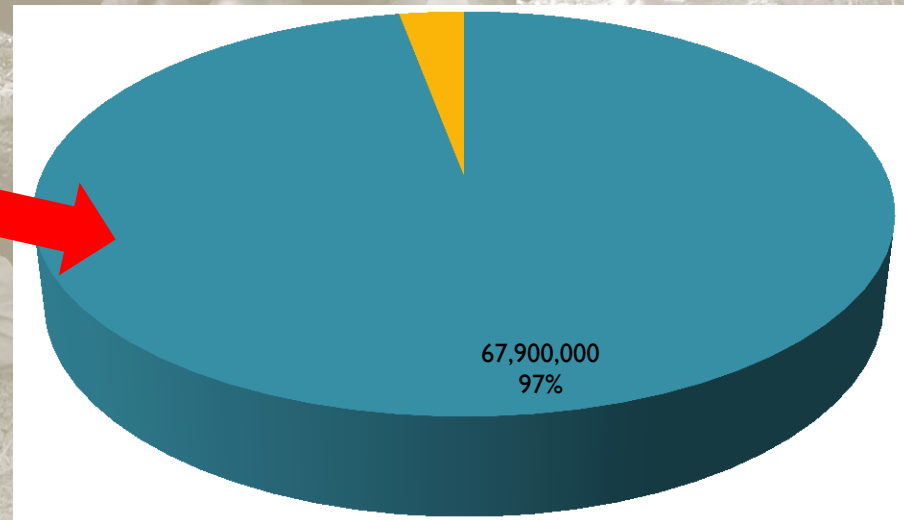

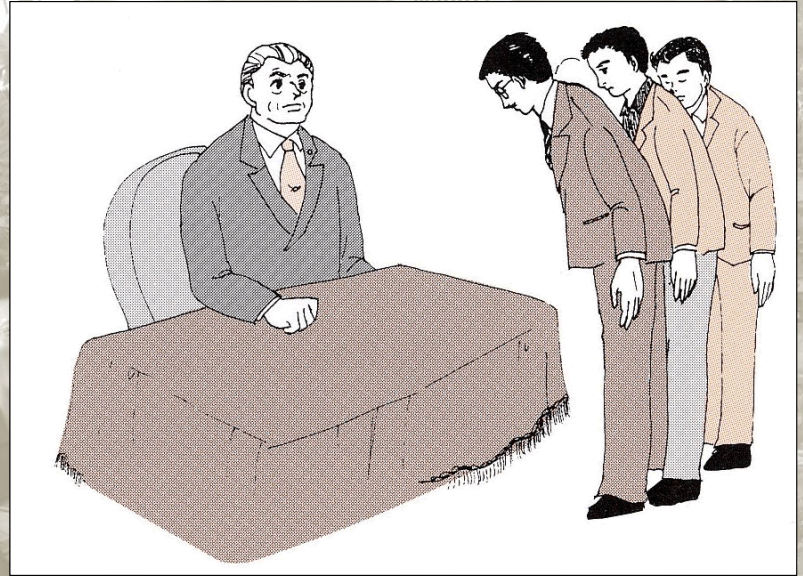
